LA CLOCHE took the inside route, under a solid hold, as were all the rest, at least for the opening three-quarters, got eased outward late on the far turn as a prelude to angling sharply four wide into upper stretch, with RUTHENIA imitating her move, only one path further to the outside, got straightened away and took off in earnest after the front runners, closed in readily leaving the eighth pole, sparred with EMBARR, who herself had just gained a very slim and short-lived advantage past the sixteenth pole, went by and edged away under good handling. EMBARR swung three wide entering the backstretch, remained well off the inside thereafter, unleashed two four wide runs around the far turn, improving position before pausing for a few strides at the midway point on the far turn, then going on to improve position slightly once more approaching the quarter pole, entered the stretch and kicked in with good energy, was among a tightly-bunched host of pursuers bearing down on LAW OF THE RANGE by the tail end of the furlong grounds, grabbed the lead away from that opponent only to have the winner draw directly alongside almost immediately afterwards, got displaced after an abbreviated but spirited one on one tussle, held on gamely though for place honors. LAUGHING (IRE) was eager under restraint for a good portion of the opening six furlongs, responded positively when given a chance to run, gained ground from upper to midstretch to loom boldly, flattened out late. RUTHENIA got away a bit sluggishly from the starting gate, sat reserved from the outside for nearly three-quarters, swung five wide into upper, showed good, but belatedly energy to earn the last major award. MARTITA SANGRITA broke a beat slowly, was unhurried while racing from the outside, sat wedged between rivals in the three path leaving the five-sixteenths marker, remained under a good hold until midstretch, lacked the needed response when asked. LAW OF THE RANGE (GB) sat forwardly placed from the three path around both turns, issued a challenge in earnest approaching the quarter pole, fought her way to a slight lead during the ensuing furlong, but with several others in hot pursuit, yielded to the heavy pressure with about a sixteenth to go. THUNDERING EMILIA rated along prompted the leader from the two path for nearly three-quarters, fought with vigor until midstretch after getting asked before backing away. THE UNDERLING well rated along the inside, gave way when put to the test.
