CALL PAT outrun for six furlongs, continued well back the middle half, asked along into the lane, rallied through traffic, split foes, late bid, best while closest to the inside of the first flight. UNTAPABLE last away, moved up while keen on the outside in the first turn, continued slow to settle onto the backstretch, advanced to challenge in the second turn, narrowly showed the way into the lane, clear a furlong, drifted out slightly, responded when challenged by the winner late, held the place. STREAMLINE raced in mid pack, moved closer in some traffic off the inside late backstreet, continued some traffic second turn, clear for the drive on the outside, staged a mild rally to be getting to the runner up late. THEOGONY unhurried early off the inside, three path through the second turn, rallied out in the strip to be going best of all at the finish while too late. SARAH SIS closest to the leader inside, moved closer then challenged along the rail in the second bend, briefly raced on equal terms with the runner up into the stretch, faltered in the final furlong. KYRIAKI settled off the pace, moved a bit closer outside, floated out five wide turning for home, weakened. MESHELL allowed to settle, four wide trip most of the way, had nothing for the drive. HIGH DOLLAR WOMAN broke on top, got clear, continued to set the pace up the backstretch two path, allowed a foe the rail second turn, stopped when headed by the runner up turning for home.
