FREE POURIN sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail then angled in leaving the backstretch, fought back when headed in the stretch, regained the advantage while drifting out a bit under left handed urging in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. TOKUBETSU bumped lightly at the start, stalked the winner off the rail, put a head in front alongside that one in midstretch and was outgamed late and just held second. RED SHARP HUMOR stalked off the rail then inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and continued willingly outside the top pair on the line. STOCK OPTION was in a good position stalking the pace three deep then outside a rival leaving the backstretch and on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SEEKING SOLACE between foes early, dropped back inside, saved ground off the pace and was not a threat. GRIP HANDS bumped lightly at the start, pulled a bit between horses early then chased off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response.
