7 FURLONGS. (1.202) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 (Includes \$100,000 BC - Breeders' Cup) BALLERINA S. (GRADE I) FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$750 to pass the entry box, \$750 to start. This race includes an additional \$100,000 in Breeders' Cup Funds for Nominees only. The NYRA purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup Nominee has finished in a n awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the Fund. Three year olds, 118 lbs.; Older 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 in 2008 or a Grade 2 twice in 2008 allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade 1 in 2007; or a Grade 2 in 2008, 51 bs.; a Graded Sweepstake in 2007-08, 7 lbs. Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Mar), by Orientate - Tasso's Magic Roo by Tasso. Trainer Sherlock Gary. Bred by Pollock Farms & Taylor Made Farm, Inc.(KY).

INTANGAROO lagged well behind in the early stages, was unhurried for a half, moved up leaving the far turn, swung six wide while making a strong move at the quarter pole, rapidly closed the gap in the middle of the track in midstretch, charged to the front inside the furlong marker and drew away under steady right hand urging. MIRACULOUS MISS devoid of early speed, trailed in the four path for a half, raced just behind the winner while five wide leaving the turn and finished well from outside to best the others. SUGAR SWIRL forced the early pace along the rail, steadied and altered course outside the leader on the far turn, made a run in the two path to challenge in upper stretch, battled heads apart inside the furlong marker and weakened in the final sixteenth. LEAH'S SECRET settled in good position along the inside for a half, closed the gap leaving the turn, rallied along the rail to threaten a furlong out but couldn't sustain her bid. JIBBOOM stalked the pace while three wide to the top of the stretch and gradually tired thereafter. MISTICAL PLAN rushed up after breaking alertly, set a rapid pace slightly off the rail to the turn, dueled along the inside into midstretch and tired from her early efforts. BARONESS THATCHER chased early between horses, advanced five wide on the turn and drifted out while tiring in the stretch. BAYOU'S LASSIE bobbed at the start, rushed up three wide, showed speed to the far turn and gave way.
