7 FURLONGS. (1.202) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 BALLERINA S. (GRADE I) FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$2,500 to pass the entry box. All starters will receive a \$1,250 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% dividende equally among the remaining finishers. Any horse that competes in both the Honorable Miss Hcp and the Ballerina will have their entry fee waived for the Ballerina. Three year olds, 118 lbs.; Older 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 in 2010 or a Grade 2 twice in 2010 allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade 1 in 2009; or a Grade 2 in 2010, 5 lbs.; a Graded Sweepstake in 2009-10, 7 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, August 14, 2010 with 27 Nominations. (Clear 81)

RIGHTLY SO was hustled from the start, drifted out while very fast early, was taken in hand with a clear lead, dictated terms while just off the rail on the turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch, easily shook off the chasing WARBLING and drew off under strong hand urging. WARBLING showed good speed, tracked the leader while under some restraint, continued to track while two to three wide on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, chased the winner into the final furlong and proved no match while just able to hold the place. JESSICA IS BACK broke a bit awkwardly, was well placed just off the pace while near the rail, shifted three wide outside the five-sixteenths pole, chased into the stretch, moved in a bit behind rivals near the three-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed response then just missed the place. DEVIL BY DESIGN was bumped in the hindquarters after the start, had PRETTY PROLIFIC clip her heels, raced on the outside while urged along, was carried five wide by QUALIA early on the turn, dropped to the rail by the five-sixteenths pole, gained ground while inside into the stretch, loomed a threat into the final furlong but flattened out then just missed the minor awards. FIRST PASSAGE was away well, settled on the outside, moved in leaving the backstretch, shifted five wide midway through the turn, advanced while continuing five wide into the stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong but also flattened out and just missed the minor awards. INFORMED DECISION came away in good order, was urged along while just off the pace, went three then four wide on the turn, steadied while between rivals at the top of the stretch then failed to rally. PRETTY PROLIFIC was bumped just after the start, bobbed while in tight quarters then clipped the heels off DEVIL BY DESIGN and stumbled, angled to the inside, saved ground while well behind the field, gained some ground in the stretch, lacked room behind the minor award winners nearing the wire and was horribly unlucky in an awful trip. QUALIA was re-shod in the paddock, came out at the start and bumped with PRETTY PROLIFIC, had the saddle slip, bore out badly on the turn and faltered then was eased in the final furlong.
