ARTEMIS AGROTERA lunged outward, making slight contact with KIPLING'S JOY, was maneuvered to be outside the early pacesetter, that being LA VERDAD, followed that rival closer to the rail nearing the end of the backstretch, continued to prompt that rival, was asked to pick it up at the five-sixteenths pole, challenged in earnest, by now under a full drive, spinning three wide into the lane, bested the nemesis during the run through the furlong grounds to arrive at the furlong marker as the undisputed leader, lengthened away before getting geared down in the final seventy yards. MY MISS AURELIA left the backstretch two wide, was hand urged angling into the three path midpoint on the turn, approached the head of the stretch and was set down for the drive home, proved no match for the winner while rallying for the place award. WILLET bobbed as the field was sent off and running, was one of three swinging outward midway on the turn, wound up in the four path, fanned a couple of paths wider into the stretch, got straightened away and finished well enough to secure the show. BETTER LUCKY lost her footing at the start, brushing with the winner before settling near the rail, got taken back towards the outside, departed the backstretch from the three path, got placed along the overland route after going halfway around the bend, by now under some hand urging, fanned into seven path during the initial portion of the stretch drive, made no headway in the late stages. LA VERDAD broke on top and maintained the advantage, set the pace at or near the two path, got confronted by a revved-up winner as the pair spun into the lane, was overhauled before completing the next furlong then steadily backed away. KIPLING'S JOY brushed from both sides at the start, was guided over to the rail by end of the chute, vacated the inside route and got angled outward entering the stretch ending up being five wide, made no impact. GEEKY GORGEOUS unhurried while chasing the disputed pace from the two path, commenced the stretch one path wider, had no rally. HOT STONES sent over to the rail at the half mile pole, cut the corner under a drive, faltered.
