1 1/4 MILES. (Inner Turf) (1.394) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 **BALLSTON SPA H. (GRADE II) INNER TURF FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD.** No nomination fee. \$2,000 to pass the entry box. All starters will receive a \$1,500 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Three year olds, 118 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Turf weights: Non-winners of a Grade 1 on the turf in 2010 or a Grade 2 twice on the turf in 2010 allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade 1 or a Grade 2 on the turf in 2009-10 or a Gra ded sweepstakes twice on the turf in 2010, 5 lbs. Dirt Weights: Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake on the dirt in 2009-10 allowed 2 lbs.; \$40,000 on the dirt in 2009-10; or four races on the dirt, 4 lbs.; A sweepstake on the dirt, 6 lbs.; three races on the dirt, 8 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track where dirt allowance weights will apply. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, August 14, 2010 with 38 Nominations. (Clear 81)

Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Apr), by Dynaformer - Slews Final Answer by Seattle Slew. Trainer Benzel Seth. Bred by Live Oak Stud (FL).

DYNASLEW conceded the lead and was taken in hand, tracked the leader while under a kind hold, ranged up on the far turn, was asked to attack the leader coming to the quarter-pole, lugged in a bit while in pursuit of that rival in upper stretch, came to SILVER REUNION coming to the furlong marker, gained the lead in the vicinity of the sixteenth-pole and gamely prevailed under strong handling. SILVER REUNION broke through the gate prior to the start, was inspected by the state veterinarian and deemed fit to run, took the early lead, raced two to three wide on the first turn, set the clear pace through solid fractions while off the rail, continued in control on the far turn, responded well when set down at the top of the stretch, dug in determinedly when faced with the challenge of DYNASLEW near the furlong marker, battled gamely on the inside and missed in a good effort. MISS KELLER (IRE) was unhurried while just off the rail, came under some urging approaching the quarter-pole, swung four wide into the stretch, rallied down the center of the course and finished with good energy but was too late on the scene. DANZON lagged at the rear of the spread out field while saving ground, remained inside through the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and finished well on the inside but reached her best stride too late. SCOLARA dropped to the rail nearing the first turn, settled on the inside, was roused coming to the quarter-pole, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. STRIKE THE BELL raced inside on the first turn, lingered towards the rear of the field, saved ground into the stretch and lacked the needed response. MARAM was restless in the gate, raced inside on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was not asked yet while off the rail on the far turn, came between rivals and was roused at the top of the stretch then also lacked the needed response. PHOLA dropped back in the early going, was reserved well off the pace, went three wide on the far turn, was asked while five wide into the stretch, dropped in behind rivals near the three-sixteenths pole, moved back to the outside and failed to rally. CHEROKEE QUEEN raced three wide on the first turn, was rated towards the outside in third, moved closer while off the rail on the far turn, was asked for her best coming to the quarter-pole, came up empty in upper stretch and gave way. MEKONG MELODY (IRE) was eager early then four wide on the first turn, settled outside on the backstretch, was urged while three wide on the far turn and came up empty. (Rail at Hedge)
