QUIDURA (GB) was asked to go to the front, set the pace while well rated through moderate fractions, was asked inside the five-sixteenths then came under a right-handed whip at the quarter-pole, hugged the hedge into upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip outside the furlong marker, dismissed the challenge of the runner-up, went back to a right-handed whip at the sixteenth-pole and was given two cracks then was placed under a strong hand ride to the wire while best. HAWKSMOOR (IRE) jostled with PROCTOR'S LEDGE after the start, went three then two wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, was asked in the two path early on the far turn, made a bid at the five-sixteenths, chased the winner under a strong hand ride in upper stretch, was put to a right-hand whip coming to the furlong marker then continued in pursuit, switched to a left-handed whip inside the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while able to get the place. INDIAN BLESSING (GB) became very rank when put under restraint early, tugged hard at the bit in the two path through the first turn, remained under stout restraint near the back, was finally let out in the two path on the far turn, came under stronger urging at the quarter-pole, was put to the whip in upper stretch, dropped in inside the furlong marker and improved position to get the show. A RAVING BEAUTY (GER) came out early then was taken in hand, saved ground under a snug hold on the first turn then was rated off the pace, drafted inside on the far turn, was given her cue inside the five-sixteenths, moved out under a right-handed whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. OFF LIMITS (IRE) went around the first turn in the three path, settled at the rear on the outside, raced three then four wide on the far turn, was roused inside the five-sixteenths, floated five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. PROCTOR'S LEDGE jostled with HAWKSMOOR early, rounded the first turn in the two path, settled on the outside, traveled around the far turn in the three path, was asked at the five-sixteenths, chased into upper stretch, was put to a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker and weakened.
