LADY SABELIA pulled her way clear leaving the five eighths marker, rated kindly on the front end, responded when set down inside the three sixteenths marker and held firm under a drive. PRINCESS VIOLET accelerated inside rivals leaving the chute and gained a forward position, eased out under urging nearing the quarter pole, gave game chase from there and slowly closed the gap. EXPRESSION , in mid pack while saving ground, came under a ride around the turn, cut the corner into the lane and closed willingly. SAM'S SISTER bobbled soon after the break then was pinched back, recovered to settle in range, rallied four wide under a ride leaving the three eighths pole, loomed a danger into the stretch but failed to seriously kick on in the final furlong. BEFORE YOU KNOW IT , three wide under urging past the three eighths pole, moved up a bit into the lane, gave hard pursuit past the furlong grounds and flattened out. STORMY NOVEL sped to a brief early lead, was wrangled back from between runners as the winner moved outside of her near the five eighths pole, stalked three wide around the turn, failed to go on into the lane and faded. FLATTERING BEA lacked speed, raced six wide in upper stretch and passed faders. TOASTING , off the pace while saving ground, was shoved along leaving the three furlong marker, continued towards the inside through the drive but failed to muster a rally. DISCO BARBIE , off the pace three wide, angled wider for the drive but failed to menace. BEST BEHAVIOR angled three wide early to stalk the pace, remained in range for a half mile then retreated under a ride.
