6 FURLONGS. (1.07?) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 *BASHFORD MANOR S.(GRADE III) FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS*. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$7,500 at time of entry. \$750 to pass the entry box; \$750 additional to start, with \$150,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Colts and Geldings 122 lbs. Fillies 119 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes allowed 2 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs.; a race other than claiming, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Saturday, June 21, 2008 with 22 nominations. (Cloudy 84)

Chestnut Colt, (Mar), by Friends Lake - Screen Prospect by Rare Performer. Trainer Flint S. Bernard. Bred by William A. Carl(KY). SCREEN YOUR FRIEND set the early pace inside, repulsed a bid by GENERAL QUARTERS leaving the turn, drew off into the stretch and held sway late. LYIN' HEART sluggish at the start, was outrun off the inside, split rivals in upper stretch then closed well to be steadily getting to the winner. SEGAL within striking distance, advanced three wide on the turn, drifted in a bit in midstretch then hung. THEREGOESJOJO reserved along the inside, angled out in midstretch, steadied when blocked with a furlong to go then lacked a late bid. MEDAGLIA D'ONORE outprinted early, raced in the four path on the turn and lacked a late bid. GENERAL QUARTERS prompted the pace three wide, challenged on the turn but tired in the drive. SILVER BAYER close up while off the rail, gave way.
