WASHINGTON BRIDGE allowed to settle outside a rival then off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch, was five wide in midstretch, rallied under some urging to the lead in deep stretch and proved best. SISTER DAWN pulled her way to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, kicked clear and held on well but was overtaken late. ZARDANA (BRZ) also pulled then stalked inside or a bit off the rail, waited off heels between foes leaving the second turn, lacked room into the stretch and to midstretch, came out, split rivals in deep stretch and picked up the show. SILVER SWALLOW angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, continued along the rail on the second turn and in the stretch and could not summon the needed late kick. WYNNING RIDE stalked between foes then outside a rival, went three deep leaving the backstretch, came four wide into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. SWEET AUGUST MOON pulled her way along to stalk the pace three deep then between horses on the backstretch and second turn, remained between rivals in the stretch and weakened some late. LADY RAILRIDER four wide into the first turn, stalked three deep then outside a rival on the second turn, continued between horses into the stretch and weakened.
