ELLAFITZ sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace along the inside, kicked away in the stretch and won clear under urging. MISS MITTAGONG pulled her way along to stalk the pace just off the rail then inside on the backstretch and second turn, came out slightly in midstretch and held the place. BAUBLE QUEEN four wide early, angled in three deep on the first turn then chased outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and was edged for second. LOVE THEWAY YOUARE broke a bit slowly, settled off the pace inside, came out in the stretch and went three deep on the line. CITY TO CITY five wide early, angled in and settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, found the fence on the second turn, remained inside in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WASHINGTON BRIDGE pulled early, chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. CHAMPAGNE D'ORO broke a bit slowly, moved up between horses then stalked just off the inside, was between foes in midstretch and weakened.
