7 FURLONGS. (1.20) STAKES. Purse \$300,000 BAY SHORE S. (GRADE III) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$1,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start. A supplemental nomination fee of \$6,000 in addition to the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstake in 2014 or \$100,000 allowed 3 lbs.; \$60,000 other than restricted stakes for two races in 2014, 5 lbs.; \$40,000; or three races other than maiden or claiming, 7 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, March 22, 2014 with 35 Nominations. (Clear 54)

COUP DE GRACE bumped soundly with FINANCIAL MOGUL coming out of the starting gate, raced at a considerable distance from off the inside throughout, was in three path and fully roused by the midway point on the bend, picked up the pace noticeably shortly afterwards, spun five wide into the stretch, made light, but sustained contact once more with FINANCIAL MOGUL, this time out-muscling that one for position, hooked up a in three-way tussle leaving the eighth pole, continued the dispute one on one with the runner up in the final seventy yards and gamely won the bob. OLIVER ZIP came away without apparent mishap, went at it head with FAVORITE TALE for much of the way down the chute and early down the backstretch as well, with neither one appearing too eager to do so, was put to a solid hold and taken back, got sent over to the rail coming to the nine-sixteenths marker, stayed glued there for the next quarter, was put to a drive and proceeded to get angled out, finished the maneuver in the four path by the top of the lane, closed in readily to loom boldly with an eighth to go, fought with vigor with another pair to deep stretch, then in a belated argument with the winner, fell short. KOBE'S BACK got away last after striking the left side of the starting gate, was unhurried while taking the two path on the turn, fanned outward until eighth wide nearing the end of the furlong grounds, displayed late energy but had to settle for the show. THE ADMIRAL underwent a three wide pursuit, issued a challenge nearing the top of the lane, forged his way to a slim lead coming to the furlong marker, but with several hot pursuers bearing down hard, showed good determination trying to fend off the top twosome before backing away in the last seventy yards. CHARLEYMILLIONAIRE rode the rail early, commenced the stretch six wide, lacked the needed response. FINANCIAL MOGUL made solid contact with the winner at the start, gave chase from the two path on the turn, doing so under encouragement, swung outward into the stretch, brushed with the top one while getting beaten to the five path coming to the three-sixteenths marker, tipped slightly wider shortly afterwards, flattened out. FAVORITE TALE off the inside, got involved in two separate duels, remained a prominent factor before weakening in the final furlong. LOKI'S VENGEANCE darted to the inside, argued for command for slightly more than a half then gave way.
