HOPESEEKER tracked the leader one from the rail through the second turn, continued down the backside from a tracking position two from the rail, rallied smartly three wide entering the final turn, and battled gamely to hold the place in the final strides. REPORTING STAR unhurried early, while dropping back to trail, raced one from the rail through the stretch the first time raced three wide down the backstretch, angled in to commence his rally from along the rail entering the final turn, and closed with interest from along the inside to just miss the place in the closing strides. BLUEGRASS PRIDE settled off the early pace racing one from the rail through the first turn, commenced a five wide rally entering the final turn, and closed with late interest four wide in the stretch drive. SHOOTING JACKET settled off the early leaders while saving ground at the rail through the second turn, commenced a four wide rally entering the final turn, and closed determinedly three wide in deep stretch. MODERN away alertly, and rushed to the lead from along the inside as they approached the first turn, dictated the pace through the second turn, was pressed by TITLE CONTENDER mid way down the backstretch, lost the lead approaching the final turn, and weakened in the late stages. TRACKER away well, and stalked the leader through the second turn while racing one out from the rail, rallied along the inside as they entered the final turn, but was outfinished the lane. SUCCESS RATE stalked the early leader through the first turn while racing two from the rail, continued to track two wide through the second turn, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon entering the final turn. GO FOR GUINNESS broke sharply, and tracked the leader two from the rail through the second turn, but began to weaken as they approached the final turn.
