MARYFIELD was unhurried early after being shuffled back a bit in the early stages, moved up between horses along the backstretch, angled out to launch her bid on the turn, swung six wide rallying into the stretch then closed strongly under right hand encouragement to get up in the final seventy yards. MIRACULOUS MISS was outrun for a half after breaking slowly, saved ground through the turn then finished strongly along the rail to gain the place. MISS MACY SUE raced between horses in the early stages, steadied in traffic on the far turn, checked while lacking room at the quarter pole, split horses in upper stretch then rallied belatedly to gain a share. BARONESS THATCHER raced in midpack while four wide along the backstretch, raced just inside the winner on the turn, steadied while blocked in traffic at the quarter pole, altered course to the inside in upper stretch then closed late along the rail. DREAM RUSH set the pace under pressure along the rail for a half, opened a clear lead in upper stretch, battled into midstretch then weakened under pressure through the final sixteenth. LA TRAVIATA pressed the pace in the three path to the turn and tired from her early efforts. SHAGGY MANE raced within striking distance while three wide into upper stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. OPRAH WINNEY angled in soon after the start, saved ground just off the early pace, angled out to threaten at the quarter pole then gave way in upper stretch. WILD GAMS checked in traffic at the half mile pole, raced wide to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. JAZZY (ARG) never reached contention while trailing most of the way.
