SWIPE broke out at the start and raced towards the back of the field early on, swung into the six path entering the lane, rallied late in the stretch but did not have enough in the final stages. BRODY'S CAUSE was unhurried early, fanned into the five path in the far turn, rallied in the stretch run and was gaining late to no avail.
