DOTHRAKI QUEEN was bumped around and squeezed back at the start, trailed the field from the inside, waited for racing room nearing the three sixteenth pole, got thru entering the lane with some gain along the inside in the stretch drive. NICKNAME was bumped at the start, recovered quickly to chase the early pace, shifted into the four path entering the lane but weakened late in the stretch. MA CAN DO IT was back early, fanned into the five path in the far turn and moved up late.
