RUSHING FALL pulled four wide early then chased outside, moved up four wide on the second turn and six wide into the stretch, rallied under urging to a short lead in midstretch, inched clear in deep stretch and held gamely. BEST PERFORMANCE in tight into the first turn, saved ground chasing the pace, went between horses on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted inward in midstretch and finished well. SEPTEMBER (IRE) hesitated to be away slowly, settled inside, went outside a rival on the second turn and six wide into the stretch and closed willingly. SIGNIFICANT FORM between foes early, stalked three wide, came five wide into the stretch, drifted in and battled inside the winner in midstretch and was outfinished. FATALE BERE (FR) chased three deep then four wide on the second turn, came out seven wide into the stretch and finished with interest. DIXIE MOON steadled early, went four wide into the first turn, chased outside, continued four wide into the stretch, drifted in and lacked the needed late kick. CAPLA TEMPTRESS (IRE) steadied early, pulled and chased between rivals, came out five wide into the stretch and could not quite summon the needed late response. NOW YOU'RE TALKING (IRE) steadied in tight early, settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, continued inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and improved position. ORBOLUTION angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, steadied off heels nearing midstretch and lacked the needed rally. MOON DASH angled in three deep early and dueled for the lead, inched away and found the rail on the backstretch, fought back inside on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. JULIET CAPULET (IRE) angled in and dueled between horses then stalked a bit off the rail, re-bid between horses on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. ULTIMA D pulled along the inside then stalked a bit off the rail, bid three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. MADELINE (IRE) pulled between foes and was in tight into the first turn, stalked between rivals and weakened in the stretch. HAPPILY (IRE) steadied in tight nearing the first turn, saved ground chasing the pace, cut the corner into the stretch, steadied again in tight nearing midstretch and weakened.
