LONDON BRIDGE settled off the pace while well off the inside, gathered some momentum leaving the five eighths pole, was put to a drive into the far turn, swung out six wide while making progress past the three sixteenths marker, kept on with a grinding run under constant left handed pressure, reeled in BLUESKIESRAINBOWS in deep stretch then edged clear at the wire. BLUESKIESRAINBOWS rated forwardly in about the two path, responded when called upon and moved between rivals to poke a head in front with four and half furlongs remaining, dueled inside two foes from the far turn to mid stretch, spurred clear a sixteenth out then gave way grudgingly. WORLDLY, five wide into the stretch the first time, moved up four wide around the second turn, bid four deep leaving the five eighths pole, dueled outside rivals, came in a bit and bumped with SUNS OUT GUNS OUT in upper stretch, was straightened away and continued willing chase to the wire. SUNS OUT GUNS OUT, in hand three wide tracking the pace, moved to a slim lead between foes with a half mile to go, battled between runners into the stretch, bumped with WORLDLY in upper stretch, continued pursuit past the eighth pole then faded late. INDIAN JONES, awkward from the gate, bobbled a couple strides out, was taken back well off the pace while saving ground, angled out and edged up between foes into the stretch, shifted out some late and closed the gap. OLD TIME HOCKEY, under a snug hold while saving ground, angled out five wide for the second time down the backstretch, ranged up to threaten around the far turn, pressed the issue to the quarter pole, failed to kick on from there and drifted out late. POOL PLAY, off the rail, made a slight run near the half mile marker, failed to respond when put to a stiff drive and dropped back. COMMANDER set the pace towards the rail, edged clear with a mile left, was joined past the five eighths pole, gave some resistance then faltered around the final turn. CEASE, well placed about two wide, retreated leaving the far turn. EVER RIDER (ARG) prompted the pace two wide, stopped when engulfed leaving the five eighths pole, was pulled up into the far turn and was walked off.
