Northern Hemisphere Three-Year-Olds, 123 lbs.; Older, 126 lbs.; Southern Hemisphere Three-Year-Olds, 121 lbs.; Older, 126 lbs. All Fillies and Mares allowed 3 lbs. \$20,000 to pre-ent, \$30,000 to enter, with guaranteed \$2 million purse including nominator awards (plus Net Supplementary Fees, if any), of which 54% of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5.1% to fourth and 2.5% to fifth; plus stallion nominator awards of 2.7% of all monies to the winner, 1% to second and 0.5% to third and foal nominator awards of 2.7% of all monies to the winner, 1% to second and 0.5% to third. Additional nominator awards to be paid from Breeders' Cup funds, not included in purse distribution. MIDNIGHT LUTE steadied after being bumped and pinched back at the start, raced far back for a half, began to angled out midway on the turn, rapidly closed the gap while swinging six wide leaving the quarter pole then unleashed a strong late run under right hand urging to wing going away. IDIOT PROOF pressed the pace three wide along the backstretch, drew on even terms for the lead at the quarter pole, drifted in a bit after opening a clear lead in midstretch, relinquished the lead to the winner a sixteenth out then held well to best the others. TALENT SEARCH broke inward at the start, was hustled up along the rail, dueled along the inside in upper stretch, steadied and altered course to the outside in midstretch and weakened from his early efforts. BENNY THE BULL hit the side of the gate then checked and dropped back early, raced well back for a half, advanced between horses on the turn then rallied belatedly along the inside. KELLY'S LANDING settled in midpack, lodged a mild five wide move at the quarter pole then lacked a strong closing response. BORDONARO checked and was bumped at the start and was never close thereafter. COMMENTATOR popped open the gate prior to the start, pressed the early pace between horses, dropped back nearing the quarter pole and steadily tired thereafter. GREG'S GOLD failed to mount a serious rally while three wide. SMOKEY STOVER raced just off the pace along the inside, swung three wide on the turn and lacked a further response. FOREFATHERS checked slightly at the start, showed speed while three wide early and gave way on the turn. Following a stewards inquiry as well as a claim of foul lodged by the rider of TALENT SEARCH against IDIOT PROOF for interference in the stretch there was no change in the order of finish.
