Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Feb), by Montbrook - Riveting Drama by Notebook. Trainer Fawkes David. Bred by Harold L. Queen(FL). BIG DRAMA sprinted clear and angled out to the three path, came in a bit with three furlongs to go, responded when asked for his best once in the stretch, increased his lead through midstretch and maintained a clear advantage under steady urging. HAMAZING DESTINY reserved early three wide, angled out five wide leaving the turn, improved his position to the furlong marker then closed willingly late to be up for the place. SMILING TIGER bobbled after the start, recovered to be close up while off the rail, drifted out a bit in upper stretch then lodged a mild late bid. SUPREME SUMMIT far back early, commenced his rally in the three path on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, moved a bit wider in midstretch for a clear path and was gaining late. WARRIOR'S REWARD outrun in the three path, moved out six wide entering the stretch and finished well late. WISE DAN close up while off the inside, dropped back a bit late on the turn then lacked the needed closing bid. KINSALE KING within striking distance four wide, angled in in midstretch for a clear path but lacked a late bid. CASH REFUND closest to the pace four wide, stayed on well to the stretch, was carried out a bit by SMILING TIGER in upper stretch and tired. RILEY TUCKER reserved early, made a good five wide run on the turn, was carried out a bit once in the stretch and tired. ATTA BOY ROY prominent five wide, was carried out a bit once in the stretch, gave way late and after pulling up in distress, was vanned off. GIROLAMO close up along the inside, gave way. PASHITO THE CHE broke in the air, steadied near the five furlong marker when rushing up along the inside then gave way.
