WORK ALL WEEK tracked three wide under confident handling, moved alongside FAST ANNA entering the lane, took over soon after, edged clear under right handed encouragement departing the furlong grounds, drifted out a bit nearing the wire and held sway. SECRET CIRCLE raced close up, was under urging between rivals after a half mile, closed steadily, ranged up outside the winner in deep stretch but was denied. PRIVATE ZONE was guided out three wide from behind the winner heading towards the half mile marker, moved closer under a ride into the lane, gave hard chase past the eighth pole, flattened out late but managed to salvage the show. BOURBON COURAGE dropped well off the early pace, gathered some momentum angling out near the quarter pole, shifted out to about the eight path in upper stretch and closed with a rush. FAST ANNA cleared early, set a strong pace in the two path, was taken on soon past the quarter pole, vied inside the winner to mid stretch and gave way. PALACE, three wide between rivals early, was steadied off the heels of PRIVATE ZONE near the half mile pole, bumped with BAKKEN around the far turn, chased between horses nearing the lane but lacked the necessary response. SALUTOS AMIGOS, off the pace four wide, came five wide for the drive and offered a mild late kick. BAKKEN, four wide, bumped with PALACE near the far turn, was under a solid ride pursuing entering the lane, had his rider lose his whip near mid stretch and flattened out. BIG MACHER stumbled at the break, trailed while saving ground into the lane, angled out a path or two in upper stretch and finished with interest. INDIANAPOLIS, sluggish from the gate, lagged while saving ground, angled seven wide in upper stretch and had belated action. SEEKING THE SHERIF, away alertly, saved ground chasing the pace and gave way in upper stretch. MICO MARGARITA dropped back under early urging, swung wide for the drive but failed to threaten. WIND FIRE was sent up along the rail early, gave hard chase saving ground past the three eighths pole, angled out approaching the lane and weakened. RICH TAPESTRY (IRE) caught between rivals past the five eighths pole,
