Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Apr), by Galileo (IRE) - Absolutelyfabulous (IRE) by Mozart (IRE). Trainer O'Brien P. Aidan. Bred by Absolutelyfabulous Syndicate(IRE).

MAGICIAN (IRE) settled outside a rival, split horses and moved up leaving the second turn, came three deep into the stretch, angled out in upper stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up late. THE FUGUE (GB) chased outside a rival, went between horses into the second turn, bid three deep leaving that turn and into the stretch, took a short lead in midstretch, inched away in deep stretch and was caught approaching the wire. INDY POINT (ARG) four wide on the hill, angled in and chased outside a rival, split horses leaving the second turn and rallied between foes in deep stretch. POINT OF ENTRY settled a bit off the rail then chased outside a rival, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished with interest. VAGABOND SHOES (IRE) saved ground stalking the pace, pulled his way up and steadied off heels into the second turn, split rivals on that turn then bid between foes into the stretch and until past midstretch and weakened late. TWILIGHT ECLIPSE bumped at the start, settled inside, split horses leaving the second turn, came out and waited off heels into the stretch, came out in upper stretch and was outfinished. LITTLE MIKE broke in and bumped a rival, had speed outside a foe then stalked that one off the rail, bid again into the second turn, took the lead, inched away and angled in, fought back inside in the stretch and also weakened late. BIG BLUE KITTEN angled in and settled off the pace inside, came out into the stretch, angled back toward the inside in the drive and lacked the needed rally. REAL SOLUTION angled in and stalked outside a rival then toward the inside, continued alongside a rival on the second turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. SKYRING settled inside chasing the pace, fell back on the second turn, came out into the stretch and also weakened. TEAKS NORTH sped to the early lead, inched away and set the pace inside, dueled into and on the second turn, fell back some leaving that turn and had little left for the stretch. TALE OF A CHAMPION angled in and stalked inside then came a bit off the rail into the backstretch, drifted out and dropped back on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch. Rail on hill at zero.
