FOUND (IRE) settled kindly while removed from the rail, edged up behind GOLDEN HORN (GB) leaving the half mile marker, angled four wide departing the far turn, moved almost in tandem with GOLDEN HORN (GB) into the lane, saw that one kick away slightly past the three sixteenths, kept on doggedly under right handed rousing to re-engage then assume the lead a sixteenth out, kept on under solid handling and held firm. GOLDEN HORN (GB) rated off the inside, moved up without much encouragement leaving the far turn, responded when put to task five sixteenths out, grabbed the lead soon into the stretch, shifted in towards the fence, met the winner's challenge in mid stretch then kept on valiantly while simply not quite good enough.
