1 $\frac{1}{8}$ MILE. (Turf) (1:42) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 Beaugay S.INNER TURF FOR FILLIES AND MARES FOUR-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$150 each which should accompany the nomination; \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,500 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weights 123. Non-winners of \$150,000 twice at a mile or over in 2014-15 allowed 2 lbs.; of such a race in 2014-15 or \$60,000 twice at mile or over since September 1, 2014 allowed 4 lbs.; of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2014-15 allowed 6 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state bred at a mile or over since September 1, 2014 allowed 8 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Gray or Roan Mare, (Apr), by Discreet Cat - To Marquet by Marquetry. Trainer Christophe Clement. Bred by Patricia Generazio (NY).

DISCREET MARQ established the front shortly after the start when exiting the dog legged turn into the backside, showed the way just off the inside in hand through comfortable splits, remained in reserve until placed to coaxing spinning just off the inside for home, got roused inside the eighth pole as rivals began to steadily close and held well to prevail. PHOTO CALL (IRE) three wide in reserve near the rear of a compact group, remained patiently handled until nearing the quarter pole, angled four wide set down for the drive at that station, kicked home with good energy to latch onto the winner at the wire to garner the place honors. RECEPTA rated three wide in range of the front, got let out continuing three wide for home, offered up a mild kick to close in at the end but was outfinished by the top pair. J WONDER stumbled at the start, tracked the pace inside behind the loose cover of the leader, cut the corner into upper stretch roused for the drive, offered up a mild kick inside but was outkicked by the top trio. TESTA ROSSI (FR) brushed the off side stall at the start, was rated just off the inside in mid pack until tucked to the fence with half a mile to run, came under coaxing three furlongs out, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid through the lane but was outkicked. RADIATOR (GB) rated just off the inside in close aim of the leader, got roused swinging just off the inside for home, failed to quicken appreciably and was outfinished. CAROLINE THOMAS brushed the off side stall at the start, was allowed to settle just off the inside at the rear, bided her time in hand until put to encouragement angled four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild late bid to close ground while trailing throughout.
