STRIKE CHARMER broke in good order, shied away from an on the muscle MY MISS SOPHIA, bumping first with the second place finisher and then with TAPITRY, made it over to the rail shortly afterwards, tracked the loose leader down the backstretch, cut the corner having gained some real estate with regards to the leader, but still well in hand, required some effort by the pilot to alter course into the three path at the three-sixteenths pole, rider utilizing a strong right handed grip and some stick work from the opposite side, kicked into her best stride after completing the maneuver, drew on even terms with the runner up in the vicinity of the sixteenth marker, cemented herself to the front with a few more jumps then edged away, hand urged crossing the finish line. TAPITRY settled into the two path after the start, was temporarily bumped onto the inside route by the troubled winner while travelling on the chute, shifted back into the two path once MY MISS SOFIA had worked her way over to the rail, began to cut into the gap during the later stages of the run around the full turn, bid in earnest after stepping into the stretch, held out with distinction before releasing the advantage with approximately a sixteenth remaining. RECEPTA put in tight soon after the start, bumped with the winner then clipped the heels of BALL DANCING right afterwards, underwent a ground-saving journey, loosely drafted into the lane behind the top one, went on to muster up a stretch sufficient enough to snag the show award. MY MISS SOPHIA appeared keen from the get-go, came in sharply towards the rail heading for the beginning of the backstretch, with a multi-membered bumping incident occurring afterwards, sailed along from the rail, isolated from the competition and pulling with some force on the bit, got put to the test by the runner up after spinning into the stretch, yielded deep into the furlong grounds and backed away. TICKING KATIE (IRE) took up the chase from the two path and lacked the necessary stretech respose. MISS ATOMIC BOMB (GB) raced two wide in the early going and gave way. BALL DANCING broke through the staring gate, was kept in control by the assistant starter and didn't run off, proceeded to come away, got clipped from behind and bumped bumped on the chute, sat reserved thereafter from the two path, entered the stretch and had no rally. SISTAS STROLL racing in foal, failed to menace.
