By invitation only with no nomination, entry or starting fees. The guaranteed purse of \$250,000 will be distributed accordingly; \$137,500 to the owner of the winner, \$50,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth, \$7,500 to fifth, \$5,000 to sixth with the remaining \$5,000 to be divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weights 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I in 2017-18 allowed 3 lbs.; of a Grade II in 2017-18 allowed 5 lbs.; of \$60,000 in 2017-18 or two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or State-Bred allowance in 2018 allowed 7 lbs.; of a race other than maiden, claiming, starter or State-Bred allowance allowed 9 lbs. LEWIS BAY bobbled at the break recovering outwards which in turn made CAIRENN shy outwards, prompted the pace of DIVINE MISS GREY from the outside four then three wide through the turn in hand, took over narrow command at the five-sixteenths patiently handled, got set down spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, drew clear under a drive to prevail. HIGHWAY STAR four then three wide in pursuit from just off the pace, got leaned on briefly three furlongs from home as AMERICAN GAL attempted to nudge her way out from in behind the top pair, denied the move holding her rightful lane, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, swung three wide into upper stretch, couldn't match the top one through the final eighth while keeping on safe to secure the place honors. CAIRENN shied out at the start half a path in reaction to LEWIS BAY recovering outwards from a bobble, crossed to chased just off the inside down the backstretch before tucking inside at the nine-sixteenths, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch, then tipped out four to five wide straightened away and improved position to garner the show honors. DIVINE MISS GREY cut the pace three then two wide under some pressure from LEWIS BAY to the outside through solid splits coming under light coaxing with seven-sixteenths remaining, got headed for command at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home shaken off a bit and weakened in the final furlong. AMERICAN GAL brushed the off side stall at the start when breaking outwards a step and conceded only a length and a half to two lengths to the front, raced three wide under rating in close range of the front, attempted to nudge her way out from in behind the top pair leaning on HIGHWAY STAR at the three-eighths and was denied the move as that rival held firm to her lane, tipped out four to five wide into upper stretch after HIGHWAY STAR cleared outside briefly roused, came up empty and was not persevered with through the final furlong.
