



## Long Island Railroad Belmont Special

Take the Long Island Rail Road to Belmont Park.  
Save time and money, buy round trip tickets in advance.  
The LIRR Belmont Special includes round trip rail fare  
and \$1 off the regular Grandstand Admission.

### New Ticket Policy

LIRR tickets are good for 14 days from date of sale; refundable within  
30 days from date of sale and are subject to a \$10 refund processing  
fee per transaction.

**Buy Before Boarding and Save:** Ticket Office at Belmont is closed  
and there are no Ticket Machines at Belmont. To avoid higher on-  
board fares, buy your ticket in advance. Belmont Package tickets  
are available at open ticket offices, as well as gray, green and  
blue Ticket Machines. Just press the "Deals & Getaways" button  
on the first screen, then select "Belmont Park". You can pay with  
cash, ATM/debit or credit cards at ticket offices and gray or green  
machines; blue machines accept debit and credit cards only.  
Ticket Machines are available at most stations.

**Commutation Ticket Holders** - Weekly and monthly ticket holders  
can use their tickets for travel to Jamaica and need only purchase  
a \$10 round-trip package ticket at an LIRR station/machine prior  
to boarding the Belmont trains to cover the fare between Belmont  
Park and Jamaica. Round-trip tickets are not sold on-board trains.  
One-way tickets for travel between Jamaica and Belmont, sold  
on trains to use in conjunction with a monthly or weekly ticket, are  
\$11. A one-way ticket from Jamaica to Belmont, purchased at an  
LIRR station to use in conjunction with a monthly or weekly ticket,  
is \$6.00.

**CityTicket is not valid for travel to Belmont Park.**

**Accessibility:** Belmont is a special event station and therefore  
services are limited. The station is not wheelchair accessible,  
and there are no elevators and only limited escalator service. It is  
necessary to use a staircase to and from most train platforms.

**Please Note:** Coolers and bags are subject to search.

## Your Safety Is Our Top Priority!

Help us make your trip safer!

- Watch the gap between the train and platform when boarding and exiting.
- Never stand at the edge of a platform.
- Never lean over a platform to see if your train is coming.
- Never attempt to retrieve something from the track area.  
If you drop something onto the tracks, notify a LIRR employee for assistance.
- Never lean against standing trains.
- Be extra careful in the winter, especially if ice forms on stairs and platforms.
- Obey posted instructions if the platform is undergoing rehabilitation.
- Avoid waiting at the end of an empty platform.

## Before Boarding Your Train



Station platforms are accessible to wheelchair customers. Please inform  
the conductor if you need assistance on and off trains. Penn Station is  
accessible through the 34th Street entrance near 7th Avenue.



Ticket purchases on board trains will cost more. Buy before boarding at  
ticket offices and machines.



Westbound PEAK AM electric trains (shown in the Monday to Friday  
westbound portion of the timetable) displaying white and red headlights  
simultaneously are short of cars. If red lights appear, you may need to  
reposition yourself on the platform to board.



Must have LIRR/MNR Bike Permit. Buy at any open ticket office or  
through the mail (4 weeks processing) or on-board trains. Bicycles  
permitted on Off-Peak Trains only. See Holidays reference notes.

## On Your Train



Please make sure that your ticket is available for immediate  
presentation to the conductor when the "All Tickets Please"  
announcement is made. If you must change trains en route, please  
hold on to your ticket for presentation on subsequent trains. On trains  
that stop at Jamaica, two inspections of your ticket are made, both  
before and after the Jamaica stop.



Most LIRR trains have restrooms in every other car. These are  
always the odd-numbered cars. Check the car number on the outside  
or the inside of the car to locate a restroom equipped car.



The Long Island Rail Road is a smoke-free public transportation  
system. Smoking is prohibited at all times on all trains and in all  
waiting rooms, elevators, staircases and enclosed waiting areas.



Luggage should be stored in overhead racks and not take up seat  
space or block the aisles or doorways of trains. It may not be left  
unattended; customers must remain near their luggage. Bags and  
containers are subject to random search by MTA police.

sure you do not leave anything behind. Should you forget something,  
our Lost & Found Office in Penn Station, located in the Main Gate  
area opposite tracks 13-14, will be happy to help. Office is open  
weekdays 7:20 AM - 7:20 PM or call (718) 217-5477.

bags or other disposable items and deposit them in the receptacles  
on the station platform. Newspaper recycling baskets are conveniently  
located on the concourse level at Penn Station.

<b>Note 2</b>	Train runs Saturday and Sunday, September 10 & 11 Only.
<b>Note 3</b>	Train runs Saturdays & Sundays September 17 - October 30.
<b>Note 4</b>	Train runs Saturdays & Sundays September 10 - October 30.
<b>J</b>	Change at Jamaica. The track of your connecting train will be announced.
<b>Z</b>	Train time is approximate. Train is scheduled to depart 30 minutes after the last race.
