FLEET INDIAN raced close up along the inside early, angled out approaching the stretch, swept four wide to the front turning for home, drew clear then dug in gamely when confronted by BALLETO inside the eighth pole and held that rival safe under a drive. BALLETO (UAE) was outrun early, advanced outside on the turn came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside but could not get past the winner. ROUND POND flashed good speed from the start, contested the pace while between rivals, earned a short lead nearing the stretch but could not stay with the winner in the drive and tired in the final furlong. TEAMMATE lunged in the air at the start, was urged up outside, contested the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. SWEET SYMPHONY was outrun early, raced inside on the turn, came wide into the stretch and had no response when roused. TAKE D' TOUR was hustled up inside, contested the pace for three quarters and tired.
