1½ MILES. (1.452) STAKES. Purse \$350,000 *BELDAME S. (GRADE I)* FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By invitation only with no subscription fees. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Weight for age. Three-year-olds. 120 lbs.; older, 123 lbs. The New York Racing Association will select a field of (14) invitees by Saturday, September 18. The owner and/or trainers of these (14) selected horses will be required to notify NYRA of their intentions to participate in the Beldame no later than Saturday, September 25. A list of alternates will be published on Sunday, September 26. Mrs. John E. Cowdin has donated a perpetual cup to be held by the owner of the winner for one year. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. (Clear 65)

LIFE AT TEN assumed a forward position soon after the break, patiently stalked the leader from the three path until the seven-sixteenths pole, gradually ranged up to the front runners, reached even terms with that pair turning for home after being called for run simultaneously with UNRIVALED BELLE, bested that foe during a brief duel, left the furlong grounds with a clear advantage and safely maintained it while being kept busy to the wire. UNRIVALED BELLE prompted QUEEN MARTHA from the outside, under a good hold for nearly three-quarters, moved to engage that opponent, with the top one, tagging along just to the outside, was set down in preparation for the stretch run, raced heads apart with the winner for about a sixteenth of a mile, dropped back a bit after failing to keep pace, but continued on with good courage during the last eighth to be clearly second best. PERSISTENTLY loped along in the back of the pack during the opening stages, was coaxed along from the outside leaving the seven-sixteenths pole, fanned four wide into the stretch, rallied mildly for the show, while never posing a threat to the top twosome at any time. QUEEN MARTHA urged from the gate, was taken in hand after establishing early command, cut the pace from the inside, under the watchful eye of UNRIVALED BELLE, continued along on the same scenario until midway on the second bend, was put to the test by the top pair as that trio approached the quarter pole, proved no match for either one, despite being called for run, and steadily tired from that point. MISS MATCH (ARG) placed under a good hold at the start, was allowed to settle into stride, gradually moved forward leaving the chute, angled outward coming to the quarter pole, but had no stretch offering.
