ROYAL DELTA moved up willingly after the break to take up the role of primarily pursuer, sat patiently parked just to the outside of IT'S TRICKY as the front running twosome made their way down the backstretch, was let out a notch at the half mile pole and latched on to the previously mentioned opponent, unleashed her challenge when ready coming to the midway point on the turn, overpowered that foe and took over, the steady hand urging being applied by her pilot contrasting sharply with the stronger handing being used on the runner up, drew out to a commanding margin while put to a brisk hand ride from upper to midstretch, got geared down once past the eighth pole, winning as much the best, handily. IT'S TRICKY broke on top and established control after being lightly hand urged in the opening stages, showed the way well out in the track while proceeding down the backstretch, began the run around the bend much the closer to the inside and feeling the presence of the winner, got overhauled approaching the three-eighths pole despite having been put to a drive, remained a slight distance behind for a while then fell back steadily late on the turn, was switched over to a mild hand ride past the sixteenth pole, reaching the finish line in plenty of time to preserve the place. GO UNBRIDLED saved ground until the quarter pole and was clearly no match for the top twosome. MARISTAR raced along the outside, was urged on the turn, failed to menace. CASH FOR CLUNKERS hit the left side of the starting gate, gave futile chase on the first two finishers towards the two path on turn, folded.
