For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$3,000 (in addition to the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight for age. Three-year-olds. 120 lbs.; older, 123 lbs. Mrs. John E. Cowdin has donated a perpetual cup to be held by the owner of the winner for one year. MIDNIGHT BISOU attained a forward position after suffering a few bumps early on the chute, was held in reserve forcing the issue from along the inside route, hitched up to SPRING IN THE WIND, responded when let out a notch approaching the conclusion of the backstretch to grab away the lead, wasn't able to shake loose and found herself in a duel with the aforementioned rival instead, finally put that foe away only to have the runner up lurking dangerously two paths wider in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, got called upon for more at that station, turned into the lane hand driven and moving to the outside, was eventually steered into path three and into close proximity to WOW CAT, saw the twosome bump solidly into each other in short order, ventured on with willingness finally kicking free of the nemesis in the last sixteenth. WOW CAT (CHI) took up residence in the three path after the start, proved rateable stalking the front runners until the half mile pole, left that station having been switched over to a brisk hand ride, inched up to the ones to catch, looked poised to strike by the five-sixteenths pole, got induced one path farther off the rail by the winner heading onto the top of the lane, was directly abreast of the top one when the pair made solid contact right around the three-sixteenths pole, vied with vigour for the next furlong but wasn't able to claim the front end, then was kept busy to the end to nail down the place. CRIMSON FROST pursued the pace from the two path, got asked to pick it up as third fraction was being finalized, was driven three wide into the lane, went on to secure the show. ANOTHER BROAD bumped after the start, dove over to the rail, took it until the end of the bend, was under a drive cutting the corner into the stretch, proved no match. SPRING IN THE WIND bounced between rivals for several jumps after the field had been sent off and running, remained in the two path after having established the top, was hand urged showing the way on a narrow lead, with the winner latched on putting on some pressure from along the inside route, saw MIDNIGHT NIGHT poke a head down in front approaching the half mille pole, proved to be a stubborn one during the ensuing furlong, matching stride for stride over the next furlong, began to fall back even though urged a little up the road by the five-sixteenths pole then retreated even more readily down the stretch.
