OSCAR PERFORMANCE hit the off side stall at the start getting away slowly and was coaxed to split foes soon after the start taking the front a sixteenth into the run and showing the way settling in hand along the inside while under attendance from BIG SCORE to the outside, remained patiently handled showing the way along the hedge in a good rhythm moving comfortably down the backstretch through sensible splits, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to run as the pressure in behind intensified, cut the corner into upper stretch, edged away under a drive to the eighth pole and held well to the finish kept to task. CALLED TO THE BAR (IRE) forwardly placed in the two path nearing the opening bend, got bumped in a bit tight with YOSHIDA to his outside before taking to the hedge into the turn, tracked the pace along the inside setting up behind the cover of the leader, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, rallied willingly to chase the winner home safe for the place honors. HOMESMAN saved ground in mid pack, swaying a bit to and fro from the two path to the hedge down the backstretch while seemingly trying to keep loose cover in front, tipped out to the two path six furlongs from home and rode the two path from that point onward, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, swung four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick to be along for the show honors. GOOD SAMARITAN brushed the off side stall at the start, settled unhurried saving ground near the rear, tipped out two to three wide five furlongs from home, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to run, swung three wide at the quarter pole and kicked on belatedly to just miss for the show honors. YOSHIDA (JPN) bumped at the start by ARKLOW breaking outwards, bumped early with CALLED TO THE BAR entering the opening bend, settled two then three wide just off the pace, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, cornered four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid to the furlong grounds, then weakened in the late going. MAKARIOS two to three wide in mid pack, came under coaxing half a mile from home, angled seven wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid to improve position in the stretch. WHITECLIFFSOFDOVER two to three wide in mid pack behind the cover of YOSHIDA, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, spun four wide into upper stretch and offered no response. BIG SCORE four wide into the first turn forwardly placed, tucked to attend the leader from the two path midway on the opening bend, settled in hand latched on at times to OSCAR PERFORMANCE to his inside, came under urging nearing the midway point on the far turn, spun three wide at the quarter pole and weakened in the stretch. TICONDEROGA three to four wide near the rear, came under coaxing half a mile from home, angled out seven wide into upper stretch and made no impact. SENIOR INVESTMENT three wide through the first turn. settled four wide near the rear, came under coaxing with half a mile to run, swung three wide for home and made no impact. ARKLOW broke out at the start bumping YOSHIDA, raced three wide through the first turn before chasing four wide in the clear down the backstretch in mid pack, came under a ride three furlongs out, angled six wide into upper stretch and tired.
