An entry fee of \$10,000 (US) will be due at time of entry (Fees are payable to the New York Racing Association, Inc.) The purse for the Belmont Derby Invitational shall be divided as follows: \$670,000 to the owner of the winner, \$230,000 to second, \$125,000 to third, \$85,000 to fourth, \$50,000 to fifth, \$35,000 to sixth, \$30,000 to seventh and \$25,000 to eighth. Weights: Northern Hemisphere Colts and Geldings 122 lbs. Fillies 119 lbs. Southern Hemisphere* Colts and Geldings 126 lbs. Fillies 123 lbs. Bay Colt, (Mar), by Galileo (IRE) - Walklikeanegyptian (IRE) by Danehill. Trainer Aidan P. O'Brien. Bred by Mrs F. H. Hay (IRE).

DEAUVILLE (IRE) tucked into the two path after the start, was patiently handled stalking the pacesetter from the two path in the early going, remained on hold, but from between rivals beginning in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, spun into the stretch and bid in earnest getting set down to a drive, wandered out to be four to five from the top of the lane to the furlong grounds, shifted gradually towards the inside after having grabbed away the advantage, with CAMELOT KITTEN following suit, dug in gamely belatedly to reach the wire first. HIGHLAND SKY loped along the hedge early, moved outward until four wide by the midway point on the far turn, angled into the six path heading for upper stretch, got straightened away and finished with good energy to procure the place. BEACH PATROL hung out in the four path on both turns, mustered up good courage down the stretch to secure the show. CAMELOT KITTEN lightly bumped at the start, sat reserved in the two path, was put a drive for the drive, shied in slightly and away from the winner at the eighth pole, flattened out. SURGICAL STRIKE off the inside throughout, vied in the three path as the widest of three from midway on turn two to midstretch before weakening. LONG ISLAND SOUND lightly bumped from both sides in the shadow of the starting gate, took the three wide on the second turn after being closer to the inside on the first turn, was put to some encouragement and asked to pick it up at the three-eighths pole, commenced the stretch but angling five wide, made no headway. APPLICATOR underwent a ground-saving journey, was already under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, had no impact. RALIS bobbed slightly as the field was sent on its way, saved ground to the quarter pole, failed to muster up a solid offering after getting angled out in upper stretch. HUMPHREY BOGART (IRE) climbed for several strides making his way to the two path proceeding down the homestretch, sat wedged between rivals after leaving the first turn, came into the stretch and made no headway. AIROFORCE lightly bumped from both sides right after the start, raced three wide on both turns, never reached a contending position. AQUAPHOBIA unhurried in the two path until the quarter pole, failed to menace. TOUGHEST 'OMBRE established control in short order, rated kindly setting the initial splits on a loosely-contested lead, felt an uptick in pressure after slightly more than halfway around the second turn, got called upon for the drive home, vied inside two others until the furlong grounds before faltering. CALL PROVISION strung out three wide on the opening bend, worked his way onto the inside route on the subsequent one in time to cut corner into the lane in hand as the trailer in this field.
