IRISH MISSION under stout restraint in close aim of the front behind cover along the hedge, grew a bit keen seven furlongs out beginning to pull more noticeably on the bit, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, angled three wide into the clear at the head of the stretch, rallied willingly to take over just inside the eighth pole, dug in and was displaced inside the final sixteenth, fought on valiant to the end to secure the place repulsing the late running REFLECTING by a nostril. REFLECTING saved ground content at the rear, remained patiently handled until three furlongs from home, came under coaxing at that juncture, angled four wide into upper stretch, rallied willingly through the stretch surging late and just missed for the place honors.
