2 MILES. (Turf) (3.343) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 **BELMONT GOLD CUP INVITATIONAL S. FOR FOUR- YEAR- OLDS AND UPWARD.** By invitation only with no nomination, entry or starting fees. The purse to be divided as follows \$110,000 to the owner of the winner, \$40,000 to second, \$24,000 to third, \$12,000 to fourth, \$6,000 to fifth, \$4,000 to sixth with the remaining \$4,000 divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weights, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$200,000 at a mile or over in 2013-14 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Graded Sweepstake in 2013-14, 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming or starter at a mile or over in 2014, 6 lbs.; such a race in 2014, 8 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. (Cloudy 74)

Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Apr), by Kitten's Joy - Iteration by Wild Again. Trainer Pletcher A. Todd. Bred by Kenneth L. Ramsey & Sarah K. Ramsey(KY).

CHARMING KITTEN two to three wide in mid pack, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, began to angle to the four path just inside the five-sixteenths, spun four wide for home, rallied into contention a furlong from home, took over inside the final sixteenth and inched away in the last jumps to prevail. IRISH MISSION under stout restraint in close aim of the front behind cover along the hedge, grew a bit keen seven furlongs out beginning to pull more noticeably on the bit, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, angled three wide into the clear at the head of the stretch, rallied willingly to take over just inside the eighth pole, dug in and was displaced inside the final sixteenth, fought on valiant to the end to secure the place repulsing the late running REFLECTING by a nostril. REFLECTING saved ground content at the rear, remained patiently handled until three furlongs from home, came under coaxing at that juncture, angled four wide into upper stretch, rallied willingly through the stretch surging late and just missed for the place honors. TWILIGHT ECLIPSE just off the inside in close aim attending the leader, took over placed to encouragement at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner for home, dug in under threat to the eighth pole, got headed inside that station and weakened in the late stages. SKY BLAZER just off the inside in mid pack, shifted to the three path at the seven-sixteenths just prior to coming under encouragement midway on the last turn, spun five wide for home, weakened in the stretch while improving position late on. SPY IN THE SKY just off the inside towards the rear between foes, got urged along three furlongs from home, continued into upper stretch just off the inside and weakened in the drive. AULD ALLIANCE (IRE) just off the inside towards the rear, came under coaxing shifting three to four wide at the half mile pole, angled five wide into upper stretch, made no headway. EAGLE POISE three to four wide in mid pack, got spirited up three furlongs from home, angled seven wide into upper stretch, offered no response. DRAW TWO just off the pace three wide, came under coaxing nearing the five-sixteenths, continued three wide for home, came up empty in the lane. COMES THE DREAM in reserve on the pace inside, marshaled the field through sensible splits under attendance to the outside, came under urging as TWILIGHT ECLIPSE took over at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner and faltered. MAMBO MAN three wide in close aim of the front, began to retreat through the field at the half mile pole and was not persevered with in the stretch.
