2 MILES. (Turf) (3:17) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 Belmont Gold Cup Invitational S. (Grade II) AN INVITATIONAL FOR FOUR-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By invitation only with no nomination, entry or starting fees. The purse will be divided as follows \$220,000 to the owner of the winner, \$80,000 to second, \$48,000 to third, \$24,000 to fourth, \$12,000 to fifth, \$8,000 to sixth with the remaining \$8,000 to be divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. NYRA has entered into an agreement with Hoppegarten Race Course in Germany for the winner of the Group Two Oleander-Rennen to receive an automatic invitation to the Belmont Gold Cup. Weights, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$200,000 at a mile or over in 2017-18 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Graded Sweepstake at a mile or over in 2017-18, 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state bred allowance at a mile or over in 2018, 6 lbs.; of such a race in 2018, 8 lbs. A Trophy will be presented the winning owner. (Clear 76)

CALL TO MIND (GB) was hustled along for the initial few jumps securing the pocket, rated kindly tracking the leader, slipped into path two the second time on the backstretch, was in hand working his way to the front on the final turn, got turned loose spinning into the lane, lost little if any of its lead during the ensuing furlong, held well in the final stages to prevail. CANESSAR (FR) saved ground in the early stages, moved into path two soon after leaving the second bend, continued to remain on hold all the way to the quarter pole, was under a drive heading home, altered course to be outside the winner in midlane, continued onward willingly nailing down the place. PRINCE OF ARRAN (GB) quickly placed along the inside route, gradually shifted into path three from the half mile pole to midpoint, got driven slightly wider into the lane, rallied for the show. ROCKETRY steadily moved up taking the inside route, in part because of various opponents abandoning it, got cued up angling three wide into the stretch, made no late headway. FUNNY KID rated in range two wide, swung four wide into the stretch, had no rally. NESSY reserved in path two, raced four wide on the last turn, had no response. COOPTADO (ARG) off the inside, stalked the leader two wide during the early going, went about the task one path wider off the rail after leaving the half mile pole, was backing away before arriving at the quarter pole and continued to do so once into the stretch. POSTULATION set the pace from the hedge, yielded readily when challenged by the top one past the half mile pole and faltered.
