LADY ELI took up in position in midpack from off the inside, departed the backstretch from the four path, tipped a bit wider and unleashed a strong run from the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home with good momentum, powered her way to the front during the run through the furlong grounds, extended the margin maintaining her impressive kick to the end. ITSONLYACTINGDAD vacated the inside route heading for the end of the backstretch, picked up the pace fanning outward into the stretch, wound up towards the six path by the conclusion of the maneuver, came home with good energy to procure the place. OUTSTANDING (IRE) raced in midpack placed in the two path, was between rivals on the far turn, was set down angling three wide into the stretch, finished willingly enough to earn an equal of the show award. SENTIERO ITALIA off the inside throughout, was hung out in the four path on the far turn, held on well to tie with OUTSTANDINGLY for third. STRICT COMPLIANCE got away sluggishly, was mostly two wide to the half mile pole, took one path wider on the second bend, got guided towards the middle of the course from upper to midstretch until eight wide, closed in well once straightened away. CONSUMER CREDIT was in the two path between opponents on the far turn, moved out into the seven path during the opening phase of the stretch run, lacked the needed late response. SHARLA RAE off the inside, made no impact. MISS CHATELAINE outrun early, improved position in a non-threatening manner. PINE NEEDLES broke alertly, yielded to LADY ZUZU on the first turn, was placed into two path afterwards, stalked the new leader, made a successful challenge approaching the quarter pole to lead a revved-up herd into the lane, proved powerless when confronted by the winner in midlane, backed away steadily after relinquishing. SPANISH QUEEN faltered off a ground-saving trip. OLORDA (GER) along the inside, tired. LADY ZUZU cleared to the lead and over to the rail nearing the end of the first turn, briefly spurted off from the competition, came under pressure from PINE NEEDLES, yielded to that foe late on the far turn and tired. DARING DUCHESS forwardly placed three wide, folded. GYPSY JUDY took up the chase from the two path, checked when done at the quarter pole.
