The Belmont Oaks Invitational field will be limited to 14 starters. (Showery 85)

CONCRETE ROSE forwardly placed from the start, settled attending the leader in closest range from the two path in the clear, remained patiently handled as the field took closer order nearing the quarter pole and the pace intensified, spun just off the inside for home set down for the drive, rallied to issue a challenge and take command a furlong from home, then edged clear under a drive to prevail. JUST WONDERFUL lunged at the start striking the off side stall and was away in a bit of a langle, raced three then two wide through the first turn near the rear of the field before being carried out to the eight path in behind rivals and forced to steady into the backstretch with six and a half furlongs remaining as NEWSPAPEROFRECORD got out rankly from the inside, tucked three to four wide soon after taking up cover behind NEWSPAPEROFRECORD and CAMBIER PARC, came under light coaxing nearing the quarter pole three wide, angled six wide into upper stretch and offered up a good kick to close stoutly outside and just got up for the place honors showing good courage despite the rough trip. CAMBIER PARC three wide through the first turn forwardly placed, settled three then two wide behind the cover of CONCRETE ROSE losing some position to mid pack nearing the far turn, came under light coaxing nearing the quarter pole before being let out three wide at that station, rallied with good energy through to the finish but was nailed on the wire by the aforementioned foe while clear for the show honors. JODIE (JPN) coaxed from the gate, established the front and showed the way in hand along the inside settling into a comfortable rhythm down the backstretch through sensible splits, came under light coaxing three furlongs from home quickening the tempo and coming under increased pressure from CONCRETE ROSE to the outside, cut the corner roused into upper stretch, duq in under threat and was collared a furlong out, weakened in the late stages while preserving the last major share. DYNA PASSER settled just off the inside at the tail of the field, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, angled out seven wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild bid. CAFE AMERICANO three wide through the first turn to the outside of NEWSPAPEROFRECORD, got carried out by that rival as she grew rank to the inside and was floated eight paths off the inside into the backstretch with six and a half furlongs to run, tucked four wide with six furlongs remaining taking up cover behind NEWSPAPEROFRECORD, tucked three wide into the far turn, came under coaxing nearing the guarter pole, swung five wide at that station, improved position briefly before weakening in the final furlong. CORAL BEACH (IRE) steadied to the outside of NEWSPAPEROFRECORD into the first turn, raced just outside and behind that rival through the opening bend, got carried out as that foe grew rank and was forced to check twice into the backstretch near the six and a half furlong marker losing about two lengths of ground before being able to tuck three then two wide six furlongs out, settled behind the cover of OLENDON midway, tucked inside half a mile from home, came under light coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch and offered no response. OLENDON (FR) settled in hand tracking from just off the pace along the inside, remained patiently handled until nearing the quarter pole, got set down spinning just off the inside for home in contention and came up empty in the stretch. NEWSPAPEROFRECORD (IRE) away well, grew rank when wrangled under a firm hold into the first turn along inside, tipped out to the two path midway on that bend then grew rank getting out to the seven path into the backstretch carrying CAFE AMERICANO out eight wide to her outside and forcing the pair of CORAL BEACH and JUST WONDERFUL to check and steady outside and in behind her with six and a half furlongs remaining, tucked briefly to the two path before taking to the three path to remain in the clear six furlongs out while continuing under a firm hold, got given some rein to work with into the far turn and advanced outside the top pair, got asked angled four wide into upper stretch, came up empty having used all her energy early on and was eased through the final furlong.
