ATHENA (IRE) took up position in path two after the field had been sent on its way, sat well reserved for nearly three-quarters, quickened when let out a notch as six furongs was being completed, angled sharply into the lane with good momentum, retained it after ending the maneuver in path six, closed in rapidly during the run leading up to and then through the furlong grounds to begin the last eighth as the new leader, kicked clear, kept to encouragement to the end. THEWAYIAM (FR) guided over to the hedge after the start, got rated keeping an eye on the front runners, was forced to bide time during the run around the far turn, swung into the lane having inched her way slightly to the outside, settled in and was given her cue, responded well enough to loom boldly, but for a moment, by the furlong marker, slipped by SIGNIFICANT FORM in deep stretch then reached the finish line in time to preserve the place. CHIPOLATA (FR) made contact with an incoming SIGNIFICANT FORM in the shadow of the starting gate, dove to the hedge and rode it to the vicinity of the five-sixeenths pole, inched her way into path two during the ensuing sixteenth, was let out for the drive home, worked her way into path six, had a good finsih down the center of the course, barely missed out on second. SIGNIFICANT FORM came out, bumping with CHIPOLATA, was put back on a proper course and secured the pocket, sat firmly rated tracking the pacesetter, picked up interest angling two to three wide spinning into the lane, kicked into her best and narrowed in, was beaten to the front by the eventual winner, continued onward with willkingness, with only the last major check to show for the effort. MIGHTY SCARLETT took up the chase from path two, fell back positioni-wise as the field bunched up coming up to the guarter pole, fanned out into path six during the opening half of the stretch run, staged a mild comeback. FATALE BERE (FR) purused the front runners from path two, swung five wide for the stretch run, made no impact. CAPLA TEMPTRESS (IRE) quickly cut over to the inside route, remained along it taking up the chase, moved up approaching the quarter pole after some rivals began to abandon it, moved eagerly towards a sliver of an opening a few jumps into the stretch run, steadied in tight, without having enough space with which to launch her bid, got angled out with approximately a sixteenth to go, split rivals rallying mildly. PAVED saved ground early, loped along in path two on the second bend, wandered out seven wide down the lane to no avail. TOINETTE
