SPELLBINDER broke in stride and took a narrow lead from the rail into the first turn, set a pressured pace to the head of the lane, edged away from COOPERATION and DISTORTED to take a clear nearing the furlong pole, appeared to be headed momentarily by SHARP WRITER in the deep stretch but dug back in and won gamely. SHARP WRITER raced unhurried in the early stages, angled off the rail leaving the three eighths pole and commenced his bid, rallied quickly into the stretch from the extreme outside, appeared to put his head in front in the late stages but was outfinished by the winner. COOPERATION stalked the winner from the rail while well in hand for six furlongs, shifted outside SPELLBINDER into the lane but could not muster the needed response. DISTORTED prompted the winner from the outside to the head of the lane and weakened. TEXCESS stumbled sharply at the start and fell well back then was never a factor. ATTACK FORCE had no speed in a dull effort.
