POSITIVE RESPONSE broke in stride but allowed MICHAEL THE MAN to take the lead and prompted that rival early, moved up on the outside to apply more pressure, disposed of MICHAEL THE MAN once in the stretch, edged clear briefly but drifted inward leaving the sixteenth pole and held. AWESOME GEM fell back early from the rail and raced unhurried to the second turn, saved ground into the lane while collecting his full stride, had to shift out in the lane for a clear path and finished full of run. HUDSON LANDING was forwardly placed early from just off the rail, saved ground on the second turn to rally into the stretch, lost some of his punch late while coming out slightly and bumped by ANTHONY'S CROSS. ANTHONY'S CROSS was forwardly placed three wide to the backstretch, remained out on the second turn, rallied into the stretch then lacked room between POSITIVE RESPONSE and HUDSON LANDING inside the sixteenth pole and had to steady hard. MICHAEL THE MAN was hustled to the lead into the first turn and crossed to the rail, met the winners bid at the half mile pole, dueled into the stretch and faded. BONFIRE KNIGHT (GB) lacked early speed, came three wide to the stretch and closed too late. GALLANT SON was permitted to settle early from the rail, eased out into the second turn, offered a menacing bid four wide into the stretch but flattened out in the final furlong. WHERE'S THE REMOTE lagged early, raced three and four wide throughout and failed to rally. The stewards posted the inquiry and reviewed the late stretch run of POSITIVE RESPONSE. The ruled that for causing interference twice in the final sixteenth to ANTHONY'S CROSS, POSITIVE RESPONSE was disqualified from first and placed fourth.
