1 1/4 MILES. (Turf) (1.452) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 *BERNARD BARUCH H.(GRADE II) A HANDICAP FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$200 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box, \$1,000 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. DIRT Weights: Three year olds, 120 lbs.; Older, 126 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake on the dirt in 2005-06 allowed 2 lbs.; \$40,000 on the dirt in 2005-06, 4 lbs.; four races on the dirt, 6 lbs.; three races on the dirt, 8 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered). A Trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, August 12, 2006 with 25 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run a t One Mile and One Eighth on the main track.)

Chestnut Gelding, (Jan), by Ashkalani (IRE) - Golden Way (IRE) by Cadeaux Genereux (GB). Trainer bin Suroor Saeed. Bred by Gainsborough Stud Management Ltd(IRE).

ASHKAL WAY (IRE) was taken under a firm hold and angled to the inside nearing the first turn, was unhurried for a half, launched a rally slightly off the rail at the three-eighths pole, swung four wide at the top of the stretch then unleashed a strong late run under left hand urging to get up in the final fifty yards. DREADNAUGHT raced in good position while saving ground for six furlongs, angled between horses nearing the quarter pole, lodged a strong bid to threaten in midstretch, battled into deep stretch but couldn't withstand the winner's late charge.

INTERPATATION was outrun early along the inside, trailed to the far turn, slipped through along the rail advancing into the stretch then rallied belatedly along the rail. T. D. VANCE took the lead soon after the start, set the pace along the rail to the turn, opened a clear lead in upper stretch, battled into deep stretch and yielded late. LEADWITHYOURCHIN was unhurried for seven furlongs while between horses, lacked the needed response when called upon. ETESAAL pressed the pace from outside to the top of the stretch and gave way. QUEST STAR raced in midpack, moved out on the backstretch, raced four wide to the turn and lacked a late response. TERRIFIC STORM stalked four wide to the far turn and gave way approaching the stretch.
