BRIGAND pulled his way up four wide early, dueled three deep then outside a rival to the stretch and weakened. NIGHT TIDE also pulled early when off the rail, stalked outside a rival then a bit off the tence, angled in for the turn and also weakened. GALEX tugged between horses pressing the early pace then stalked outside a rival or off the rail, dropped back some on the turn, came out in the stretch, was a bit
