RON THE GREEK broke a bit slowly, settled inside, advanced between horses leaving the backstretch, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, gained the lead outside the runner-up in the drive and drew clear under urging in the final sixteenth. SETSUKO bumped at the start, was four wide in the run toward the wire the first time, stalked between horses then off the rail, came out three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch, bid for the lead in upper stretch, fought back inside the winner in midstretch and just held second. UH OH BANGO settled inside then off the rail, came out leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, angled five wide into the stretch and finished with interest. HOLLADAY ROAD a bit slow to begin, angled in and settled off the pace inside, came out into the second turn and three deep into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and bested the others. NORVSKY bumped and squeezed a bit at the start, settled outside a rival then toward the inside, split foes leaving the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BOXEUR DES RUES chased outside a rival then between foes into and on the second turn, came out in upper stretch and could not offer the necessary response. TWICE THE APPEAL pulled between horses early then chased outside a rival, continued outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and did not rally. THIRTYFIRSTSTREET pulled inside stalking the pace, split horses on the second turn, angled in, bid inside ULTIMATE EAGLE into the stretch, was bumped by that one into the rail in upper stretch and weakened. FIDDLERS AFLEET had speed between horses then stalked inside, steadied in tight off heels nearing the quarter pole, came out some in the stretch and also weakened. ULTIMATE EAGLE pulled his way along inside, dueled along the rail, inched away leaving the second turn, bumped with THIRTYFIRSTSTREET while alongside that rival into the stretch and had little left in the final furlong. GLADDING dueled three deep then outside a rival, dropped back between foes leaving the second turn and weakened. PRAYER FOR RELIEF chased three deep then outside, dropped back into and on the second turn, was forced five wide into the stretch and gave way. VICTORY PETE angled in and stalked four wide then off the rail, also dropped back on the second turn, drifted out into the stretch and had nothing left for the drive.
