PURE AS GOLD stalked the pace inside then bid along the rail and dueled for the lead, put a head in front leaving the turn, inched away past midstretch and held gamely under urging. BORDONARO stalked outside a rival then bid three deep and dueled for the lead on the turn, battled outside the winner into the stretch, appeared to be struck with the whip of that one's rider in midstretch and continued willingly between foes late. BATTLE WON a bit slow into stride, chased off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and closed willingly outside the top pair.

TRICKEY TREVOR saved ground chasing the pace, came out past midstretch and lacked the needed rally. CARTHAGE chased outside on the backstretch and alongside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. PREMIUM SALTINE sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail then dueled between horses on the turn, fell back into the stretch and weakened. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner-up against the winner for alleged interference with the whip in the stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the videotape inconclusive.
