JAVA'S WAR hesitated at the start to get away behind his field, bided his time at the tail of the field, wheeled out seven wide leaving the second turn, moved into contention readily through the upper stretch, quickened in the final furlong and was up in time to nail PALACE MALICE in the shadow of the wire. The latter attended the pace off of the inside, took closer order inside the three furlong marker, tipped out entering the stretch, struck the front with less than a furlong to run, kicked on well but was turned away late. CHARMING KITTEN settled in hand between horses, responded when roused with three furlongs to run, ranged up five wide through the second turn, continued on willingly between horses and was gaining. RYDILLUC contested the pace to the outside of UNDRAFTED, took over after a half, opened clear on the second turn, settled into the stretch still in command, but was headed inside the furlong marker and gave way. FEAR THE KITTEN was allowed to settle, advanced between horses while five wide, angled out further entering the stretch and was making up ground. BALANCE THE BOOKS settled between horses, moved up four wide to make his bid entering the stretch but weakened during the drive and faded. MY NAME IS MICHAEL settled saving ground, weaved through traffic through the second turn and improved position. CHANNEL ISLE settled saving ground, angled out entering the stretch and finished with a belated gain. DYNAMIC SKY broke slow, was unhurried into stride and was never a factor. UNCAPTURED was close up four wide to the stretch, but came up empty between rivals and retreated. TESSERON broke slow, tucked in to save ground but lacked a response when called upon. WEST HILLS GIANT contended six wide for six furlongs and dropped out. UNDRAFTED disputed the pace off of the inside, but came up empty leaving the second turn and faded. FOOTBRIDGE was forwardly placed
