Bay Filly, (Mar), by Sir Prancealot (IRE) - Greta d'Argent (IRE) by Great Commotion. Trainer Brad H. Cox. Bred by Tom Wallace (IRE). BEAU RECALL (IRE) saved ground on the first turn, settled at the rear, raced inside on the far turn, shifted to the two path entering the stretch, angled out while put to a drive around the three-sixteenths, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to get up late. VAGABOND PRINCESS went around the first turn in the two path, settled off the pace, rounded the far turn in the two path, swung four wide into the stretch, rallied to make a bid at the furlong marker, was carried out late and just missed while narrowly able to get the place. DUBARA (GB) went three wide on the first turn. was reserved off the pace, traveled around the second turn in the three path, shifted four wide into the stretch, rallied to the lead at the three-sixteenths, led determinedly into the final sixteenth, drifted out late and was denied while clear for the show, SUPERIORITYCOMPLEX (IRE) went four wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside under a snug hold, came under urging in the three path on the far turn, made a bid at the five-sixteenths, battled under a drive into the final furlong and weakened. PRADO'S SWEET RIDE broke in at the start, was taken in hand early, raced in the two path on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, drafted in the two path on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. TAKE THESE CHAINS (IRE) went three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, drew even with the leader near the three-eighths pole, vied in the two path on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and tired. I'M BETTY G broke out at the start, was rated on the inside, drafted along the rail on the far turn, turned into the stretch behind horses, was asked near the three-sixteenths, raced under a drive into the final furlong, steadied behind horses around the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed response. NINETEENTH STREET went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch then was put to a drive and failed to rally. FULL OF ZIP set the pace on the inside, was asked while inside of a foe on the far turn, dropped back into upper stretch and gave way.
