About 5½ FURLONGS. (Turf) (1.024) STAKES. Purse \$60,000 *BONAPAW S. FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.* No nomination fee. \$300 to enter and \$300 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$60,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second; 10% to third; 4% to fourth; 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weight: Three Year Olds - 122 lbs. Older - 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 on the turf since October 18, 2010 allowed 2 lbs. \$30,000 on the turf since then allowed 4 lbs. \$25,000 on the turf since September 18, 2010 allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered in estimating allowances.) Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings on the turf in 2009-2010. Different owners have equal draw according to money earned. Second choice high earners of a same owner entry receive no consideration over a single entry. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Closed Saturday, December 4, 2010, with 22 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 5 and 1/2 Furlongs.) (Rail at 10 feet). (Cloudy 45)

DUE DATE settled at the rear of the field, was patient while three to four wide on the turn, moved to five wide at the top of the stretch, shifted further out shortly thereafter, was roused in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, closed very strongly while well out in the course, took the lead near the sixteenth-pole then powered clear under strong urging. EARLY RETURN was reserved off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch, moved further out once straightened for the drive and finished fast to get the place. BACKTALK was urged along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn, drifted out in upper stretch, closed well to make a mild bid near the sixteenth-pole then was outfinished while able to garner the show. GOLDZAR settled towards the rear, raced inside on the turn, moved out some in upper stretch, shifted back in near the furlong marker, moved around WESTERN SMOKE approaching the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly but just missed the minor awards. CENTRAL CITY came in after the start, chased the pace, raced two to three wide on the turn, gained the lead in upper stretch, led into the final furlong and weakened. ROYAL EXPRESS settled off the pace, raced four to five wide while urged along on the turn, was carried out in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. COOL BULLET was forced in after the start, raced off the pace while urged along and failed to rally. GRAND TRAVERSE settled on the outside, was urged along while five to six wide on the turn and failed to rally. MAJOR RULES was forced in after the start, raced towards the front of the field, was urged along while inside on the turn and came up empty. WESTERN SMOKE was forced in after the start, moved up to take the lead, set the clear pace, was asked for his best in upper stretch, lost the lead to CENTRAL CITY and tired. (Rail at 10 Feet)
