No nomination fee. \$600 to pass the entry box and an additional \$650 to start. A supplemental nomination fee of \$1,000 in addition to the entry and starting fees will be accepted up to entry time. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstake or \$50,000 allowed 3 lbs.; two races , 5 lbs.; a race, 7 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, October 6, 2012 with 25 Nominations. (Clear 68)

WEEKEND HIDEAWAY tucked along the inside coming to the end of the backstretch, argued for command with the runner up, with several others in close proximity, but in lanes further off the rail, got set down and shook free by the furlong marker, dug in with good determination under a drive to maintain a healthy margin to the wire. **SAINT ARTHUR** sparred with the winner from the outside on the turn, failed to keep pace after turning for home, continued onward willingly to secure second. **IN HARM'S WAY** tracked the front runners while saving ground, was under urging angling out leaving the five-sixteenths pole, proved no match. **LUCCI THE LION** four wide and roused by at three-eighths pole, mustered up a mild response en route for the final major award. **SMOOTH BERT** hit the right side of the starting gate soundly, had a wide trip and tired. **LAILA'S JAZZ** rode the rail until the quarter pole, was under a drive by the midway point on the turn, angled four wide into the stretch, made no headway on the front runners. **WESTERN GRIT** forwardly placed well off the inside for a half, had no rally. **MEET THE METS** pursued the pace dispute three wide under encouragement for a good portion of the way around the turn, had little left for the stretch drive. **JAMES JINGLE** lacked the necessary stretch response. **SLOT PLAY** took the overland route and gave way after entering the stretch. **HALF WILDCAT** chased from off the inside and tired. **TEQUILA HERO** was no factor. **OUR PEDROIA** failed to menace. **GOODTLOOK** chased the duellers three wide until the quarter pole and gave way.
